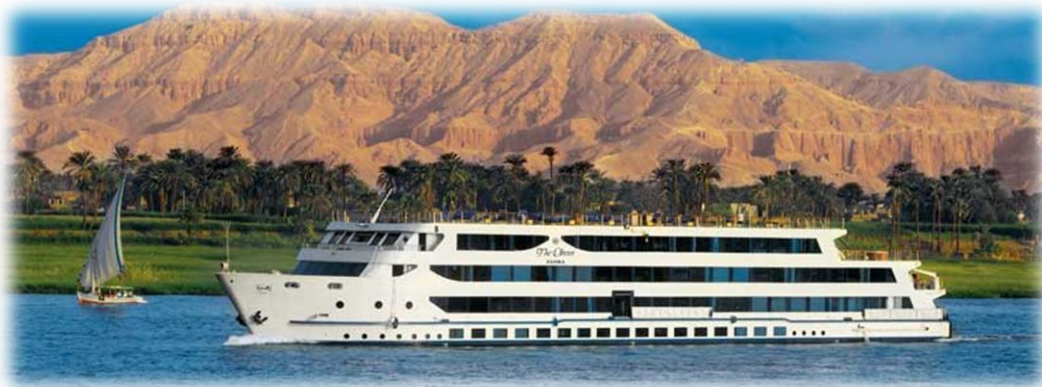
Monday March 29th

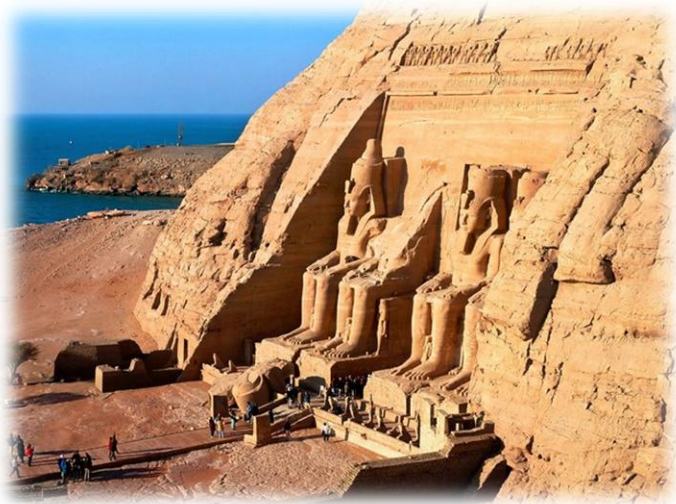


Friday 2nd April

We arrive back in Cairo, to check into our hotel and indulge in the much needed rest before we start our tour of Old Cairo and a visit to the famous Khan el Khalili Bazaar, where you can buy souvenirs, jewelry, etc:

- Islamic: Amr Ibn al As Mosque, Ibn Tulun Mosque
- Christian: St. Sergius Church (Considered to be Cairo's oldest church, dating from the 4th century AD. Built on the spot where the Holy Family rested at the end of their journey into Egypt) , St. Barbara Church , Mar Girgis Church (Best known for its wedding chamber, which dates from the 4th century AD and was reserved for marriage ceremonies) , The Hanging Church (Cairo's most famous church , built in Basilcan style) and St. Mary Church .
- Jewish : The Famous Synagogue
- Khan el Khalili Bazaar

City of Alexandria, Egypt

We leave in the early hours of the morning, around 3 am for our drive to the City of Alexandria, where we will be visiting the Montazah Palace, Bibliotheca, Morsi Abul Abbas Mosque, Tomb of the Unknown Soldier and get a glimpse of the outer view of Quaita Bay Forte.
